The text of Ennius' poems can be found in PHI Latin texts - with slightly different numbering of the lines. Ennius: translation of fragments (3)

FRL I: ENNIUS BOOK I. Nearly a quarter of the fragments that can be securely placed in any book of the Annals are ascribed to this one, and more general references to its content appear in a wide variety of sources. So unusually rich a mixture of testimony and quotation makes identifying the contents of this book less problematic and significantly more detailed than any other.

Ennius died at the age of seventy, when a bust was erected to him in the tomb of the Scipios, who, until the time of Sylla, had continued the practice of burying, instead of burning, their dead.

Reliqua historia sic contextitur: This introduces the second part of the story in which Ennius gives in Latin a text from sacred writings. In another part of the fragment it reads: “this, as is written, is the origin and kinship of Jupiter and his brothers: in this way it has been handed down to us from the Sacred Writing”. Note that part of the passage is entirely in indirect speech.

Ennius was born at Rudiae, an old Italian (predominantly Oscan) [2] town historically founded by the Messapians.Here Oscan, Greek, and Latin languages were in contact with one another; according to Aulus Gellius 17.17.1, Ennius referred to this heritage by saying he had "three hearts" (Quintus Ennius tria corda habere sese dicebat, quod loqui Graece et Osce et Latine sciret).
